- 20-mile round trip; approximately 2 hr.

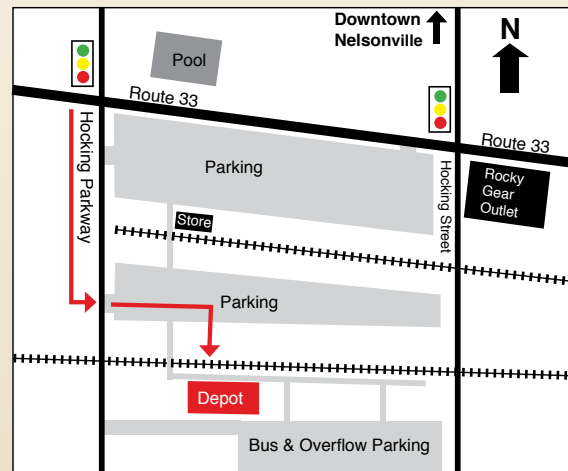

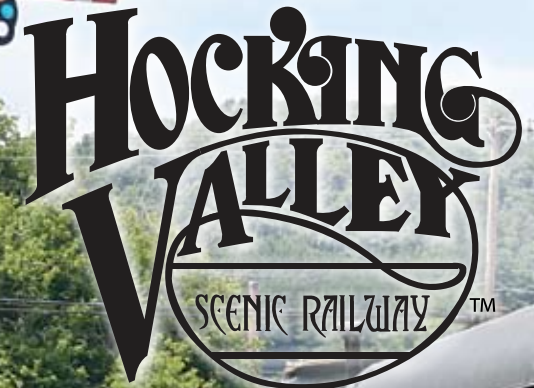
